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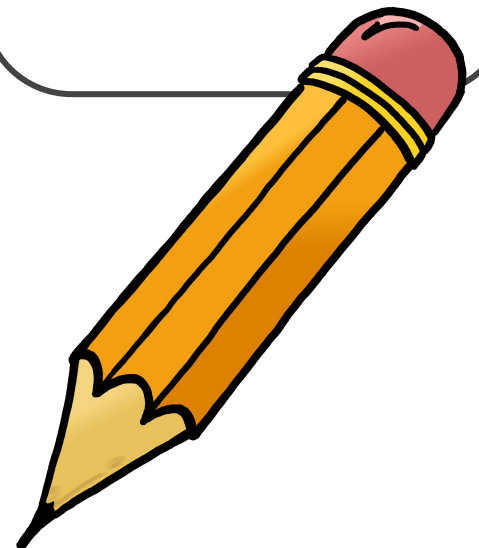

OUR WEEK OF LEARNING

Reading: Middle of the year MAP and DIBELS testing is finished! We're diving back into book clubs.

Writing: We're editing and revising our historical fiction narratives and publishing them this week.

Math: Middle of the year MAP testing is finished! We're taking our knowledge of fractions and converting them to decimals (tenths and hundredths).

Theme: Important events in Colorado history leading up to the mining era. We're compiling all of our Colorado knowledge into a virtual museum focusing on CB history.

Spelling: Long u is usually spelled u-consonant-e, as in mule. The sound /oo/ is often spelled u-consonant-e, ew, or oo, as in include, flew, and smooth (same as last week).

Grammar: Commonly misused words: to, too, two, its, it's, there, their, your, you're (same as last week).
