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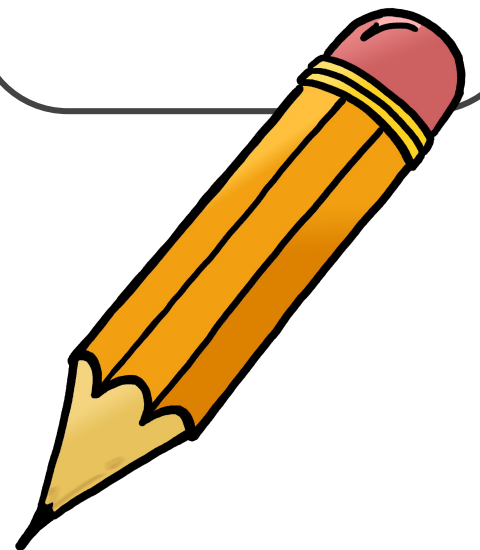

Reading: We're wrapping up book clubs and celebrating all the growth we've made. Ask us about our favorite books from the year. We'll also continue to set summer reading goals to avoid the summer slump!

Writing: We're peer editing and publishing our fiction stories. We will also create illustrations if they help add to the quality of the story.

Math: We're looking at decimals in multistep numbers stories. We've done a lot of these challenging number stories lately. They can be frustrating at first, but it's good practice to break it all down and try one step at a time.
