

Spelling Activities

"Academic" practice

1. Write the spelling words in alphabetical order. Number the words.
2. Write the spelling words in crayon or pen. Write each consonant letter in red and each vowel in blue. Number the words.
3. Print each word. Next to it, write the word in cursive. Number the words.
4. Write each spelling word three times each. Number the words.
5. Write your words with all the letters scrambled up. Ask a parent/guardian to unscramble the words on your paper. Number the words.
6. Take a "practice test" at home given by your parent/guardian. Write any missed words 3 times correctly. Number the spelling words.
7. Make a set of flashcards for studying your words.
9. Write the spelling words as fractions based on the number of vowels and consonants in each word. (Example: The word is *fraction*, consonants= 5/8 and vowels = 3/8. Number the words.
10. Write a quality sentence for each one of your spelling words. The sentences should make sense and be in your best handwriting. Don't forget to underline the words.
11. Write a paragraph using all of the spelling words. Underline the words.
12. Word hunt. Find other words that match your spelling rule.
13. Scrabble Spelling - use scrabble pieces to build words. For some sneaky math fun, have your child total the amount for each word.
14. Which is Correct? -Write words on dry erase board or sheet of paper and include misspelled words. Have child identify the correctly spelled words.

"Artistic" practice

14. Write each spelling word in a rainbow of colors. First write the words with a red crayon. Trace over the words with a blue crayon. Finally, trace the words again with a green crayon. Number the words.
15. Cut-out Letters - Use newspaper or magazine print to cut out fun letters. Have child make words using clipped letters.
16. Draw and color a picture. "Hide" all the words in the picture.
17. Write a rap song using all of the spelling words. Underline the spelling words.
18. Flower Words - draw a flower for each word, 1 petal for each letter of the word.

"Athletic" practice

19. Jump Rope while orally spelling the words.
20. Bounce a Ball - bounce a ball as you spell words - 1 bounce per letter
